



Conditions for Borrowing the 707 Class Association boats

Principle:

The 707 Class Association has purchased a number of Hunter 707 boats to assist with development of the Class through it being used by groups or individuals who may be interested in joining the Association and /or purchasing a 707, and for the provision of a boat to people to sail at key Class events who currently may not be able to afford to buy a boat (such as Universities , youth groups and Charitable sailing organisations).

Definitions:

Lender – is the 707 Class Association

User - group or individual borrowing the boat

Conditions of loan.

- A. The boat is insured for use by Members of the 707 Class Association, which means it can be used by individuals or groups with the permission of the Class Association.
- B. One individual (as a minimum) on board the boat must be a Full Member of the Class Association
- C. Lost, dropped, broken items such as the windvane, inner stays, bottlescrews, spinnaker pole, will need to be replaced asap at the cost of the User.
- D. Any additional loss or breakage below £200 in value will be at the cost of the User e.g lost/dropped items, minor repairs of sails etc
- E. All breakages, or obvious signs of deficiency, or damage must be reported in writing (email is acceptable) to the Association ideally the same day of use, or immediately after use.
- F. Transport may be provided for the boat by members of the Association, however, it is essential that the User and crew provide the main means and assistance for launching,

rigging and de-rigging the boat along with adequately attaching the boat and associated equipment to the trailer.

G. Launching and berthing – these are normally at the cost of the borrower and should be organised through the appropriate marina linked to the event.

H. Maintenance and Wear and Tear

A payment may be made for the season, or each event, to contribute to wear and tear costs. People have typically offered £175 per weekend or £300 for a 4 day event, or as deemed sensible for use in multiple events.
